

Three Important Words

John 14:1-6

- I. Words of Consolation. (vs. 1).
 - A. Jesus could see the hurt and confusion of the disciples.
 - B. The character of men to whom the Lord spoke these words.
 - C. The plea with which He ends these words of consolation.

- II. Words of Explanation. (vs. 2-4).
 - A. Jesus answers the question of where He is going. (vs. 2)
 - B. The explanation was accompanied with a promise. (vs. 3)
 - C. Jesus ends by making a statement of assumption. (vs. 4)

- III. Words of Direction. (vs. 5,6)
 - A. These words were in response to Thomas' admission of ignorance. (vs. 5)
 - B. Jesus answers the question of the way. (vs. 6)
 - C. Secondly, Jesus speaks to the question of place. (vs. 6)
