The tyranny of idolatry:

1. Idolatry demands we demean ourselves by worshiping a creation of man (1:16).
2. Idolatry replaces a love relationship with heartless ritualism (2:1-2).
–a departure initially promoted by the priests, kings and prophets (2:8)
3. Idolatry makes no demands we neglect the Lord's provision or protection (2:3).
4. Idolatry destroys any appetite for the Word of God (2:29-30).
5. Idolatry determines destiny (3:1).
it demands discipline
6. Idolatry erodes other areas of spirituality (3:2)
7. Idolatry delays blessings (3:3).
8. Idolatry breeds double-mindedness (3:4-5).
9. Idolatry develops a false sense of security (5:10-14).
