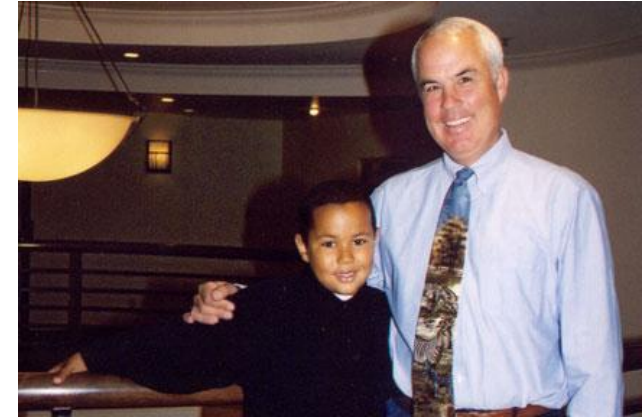
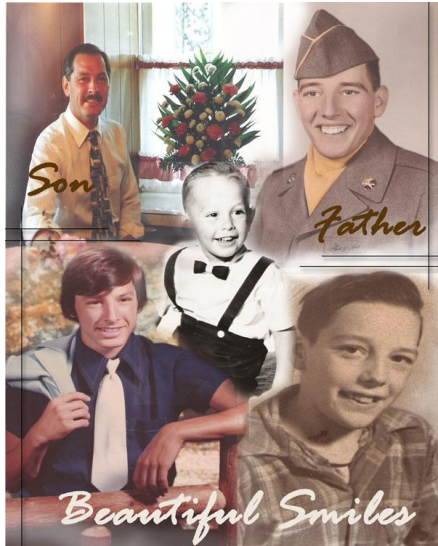
A good character is the best tombstone. Those who loved you, & were helped by you, will remember you when forget-me-nots are withered. Carve your name on hearts, and not on marble.”
